August 23-25 Amsterdam Mo Kamp Keirse

I have talked to Sue Vunesky and Jeff Reynolds. They are coming back to our fiber adventure in Amsterdam again. Sue has been working on some new projects to keep us busy along with helping make socks or a project of your choice. Jeff will do beginning weaving or offer more advanced instruction. It will cost \$35.00 to stay at the camp Friday and Saturday night. The accommodations are bunk bed type with real mattresses in cabin settings. Several people will be staying in one cabin. Jeff's cost for instruction is \$70.00 per person. Sue's fee is \$300.00 to come. So if we can get 10 machine knitters that would be \$30.00 each. This year, Resa and I will prepare a sandwich type meal for lunch on Friday and we will also handle the evening meal on Friday night. If any of you would be willing to do breakfast Saturday or Sunday or lunch or dinner Saturday, please let me know. Sunday at noon we will have leftovers before we all leave. If everyone brings food and helps out with the meals, it will keep the cost down.

If you want to do the sock machine knitting class, the total cost for the room and class will be \$65, assuming everyone helps out with meals and assuming we have at least 10 knitters sign up. If you want to do the weaving class, the total cost for the room and class will be \$105, assuming everyone helps out with meals. If you just want to come and enjoy spinning, crochet, sewing, etc you are welcome, just pay the \$35.00 to stay and bring some food. We had some vendors last year pay for staying (\$35.00) and vendor space is free. As an added note, any extra money above our costs are always donated to the camp. In case anyone thought the early registration deadline has passed, it has not! The date to enter Creative Hand Show & Sale is actually Wednesday, July 31st. Your application and fee must be postmarked by 7/31/13 to receive the \$50 price for Full Production and \$10 price for Limited Production (5 items). Starting on Thursday, 8/1/13, the application fee will be \$75 for Full Production and \$15 for Limited Production (5 items). The ending deadline is Wednesday, October 16th.
