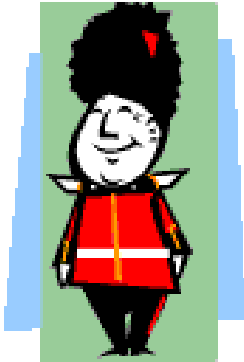
Holiday party & gift exchange
