Fiber Adventure at Kamp Keirse Amsterdam, Mo August 21-23 2015

This is a fun and relaxing weekend where you can work on your fiber related projects, read, take a walk do as you want. The weekend cost is \$60.00 per person. This fee includes the Friday night dinner, breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday, and breakfast and lunch on Sunday. The menu will be soups and sandwiches for dinner and lunch and breakfast casserole, fruit and cereal for breakfast. The only duty you have is to help with one meal--the rest of the weekend is yours!

If you are shy or just not sure about spending the whole weekend there, you can just spend the day on Saturday or just one night at a prorated rate. Bring your \$60 with you to pay to Mary Limpus when you arrive. The main building has tables, chairs and areas to spin, knit, weave, etc. The main building has one bathroom. There is a bit of a walk of about 50 yards to the sleeping buildings. These buildings are equipped with bunk beds, bathrooms and showers. There is heating and AC in all buildings. There are paved walkways that are lit at night to assist you in walking to your cabin. the pool will be open in August so bring a suit and enjoy it.
